COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will provide participants with a comprehensive approach to treating temporomandibular joint dysfunctions conservatively and postoperatively. An integrative approach including extensive examination of the upper quarter (ie, cervical spine, mandible upper thoracic spine, scapulothoracic articulation), posture, and ergonomic considerations, identifying key abnormal movement and relaxation deficits, orthopedic manual therapy, proprioception and motor control exercises will be reviewed. This course will also include a review of case studies, observation and discussion of patient video, and laboratory participation.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Become familiar with physical and psychosocial causes of temporomandibular dysfunction (TMD) and its variabilities.
- Be able to complete an objective examination of the patient with oral-facial pain with respect to joint and myofascial structures including the cervical spine, mandible/TMJ, and scapulothoracic articulation.
- Be able to make use of critical thinking analysis to form a treatment plan based on a problem list that will address all aspects of deficits.
- Introduce the concept of applying orthopedic manual therapy including joint mobilization, strain/counterstrain, active mobilization (muscle energy techniques), and soft tissue mobilization to treat TMD.
- Be able to identify and treat proprioception deficit of TMD.
- Become familiar with dental terminology with regards to TMD.

Over 20 years clinical experience, he holds a Masters degree Physical Therapy, Slippery Rock University of Pennsylvania, B.S. degree in Exercise & Sport Science, emphasis Athletic Training, Oregon State University. In addition to his dual training as ATC and PT, he is also a Certified Strength & Conditioning Specialist (CSCS) through the National Strength & Conditioning Association, Certified Orthopedic Manipulative Therapist (COMT) through the North American Institute of Orthopedic Manual Therapy (NAIOMT), Board Certified Orthopedic Clinical Specialist (OCS) through the APTA Board of PT Specialties, Fellow with the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapy (FAAOMPT), an APTA Credentialed Clinical Instructor, and is a Certified Instructor with the AQx Aquatic Running Program. He is published in the Journal of Athletic Training. He is currently engaged in original research work in the area of Proprioception. Mr. Giulietti's training in oral-facial pain and TMJ disorders began in 1993, completing a 4 month Graduate PT Residency in Orthopedics & TMJ disorders. He has completed additional training under internationally recognized Mariano Rocabado, DPT, who is currently the Professor and Dean of Rehabilitation Science Faculty at the University of Andrews Bello, Santiago de Chile, Chile. Dr. Rocabado is also Head of a Physical Therapy clinical center and Professor of Head/Neck Biomechanics at the School of Dentistry, University of Chile. Mr. Giulietti was recently (2010) asked by the Orthopedic Section of the APTA to serve as a subject matter expert for the TMJ chapter for the upcoming 3rd edition of **Current Concepts of Orthopedic Physical Therapy**. In addition to teaching seminars since 2003, Mr. Giulietti has been Adjunct Professor in the Athletic Training Curriculum, Exercise & Sport Science Department at Oregon State University. He has served as ATC in high school, university, levels, as PT in Hospital based Acute, Neuro, and Rehab units, and orthopedic settings, and more recently as ATC/PT at the Olympic level in 2000 and 2008 Olympic Trials Track & Field. He is co-owner and co-founder of Eugene Physical Therapy, LLC in Eugene, Oregon where he continues to practice full time in private practice, in addition to serving as clinic Clinical Coordinator of Education. He is husband of 16 years and father of 4 children.
