

JEFF GIULIETTI, MPT, ATC, OCS, CSCS, COMT, FAAOMPT

Jeff Giulietti has clinical experience dating back to 1988 in the professions of Athletic Training and Physical Therapy. In addition to his formal university training he has attended over 100 post-graduate courses (over 1200 contact hours) encompassing a wide variety of areas (see post-graduate education). During his Masters curriculum he was fortunate to have studied under *Jim Porterfield, PT, ATC* whose reputation for functional anatomy of the lumbar spine had national repute. Studying under *Steven Roy, MD* (who held sports medicine international repute at the time) at the *Sports Injury Clinic* prior to its close in 1992, also contributed to Jeff's commitment to always being on the cutting edge of Diagnosis and Rehabilitation.

He has served as Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) at the high school and university levels, as Physical Therapist (PT) in Hospital based Acute, Neurological, and Rehab units, and orthopedic settings, and more recently as ATC/PT at the *OLYMPIC* level in 2000 & 2008. Jeff is a Board Certified Orthopedic Clinical Specialist (OCS) through the APTA Board of Specialties, is a Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist (CSCS) through the National Strengthening and Conditioning Association (NSCA). He is a Certified Orthopedic Manual and Manipulative Therapist (COMT) through the North American Institute of Orthopedic Manual Therapy (NAIOMT) and has been recognized internationally as a Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Therapy (FAAOMPT) as having advanced competencies in clinical, analytical, and hands-on skills in the treatment of musculoskeletal (orthopaedic) disorders. He is a TMJ Specialist trained by world renowned Mariano Rocabado, DPT of Chili, Santiago, and was asked (2010) by the APTA to serve as an expert reviewer of upcoming TMJ textbook chapter. He is a Credentialed Clinical Instructor through the APTA (CCI-APTA). Most recently, he is a Certified Instructor for Aquatic Athletic Performance with the AQx Sports aquatic shoe (2009).

Jeff enjoys treating a wide variety of challenging patients, of which he has expertise in all musculoskeletal dysfunction (foot/ankle, knee, scoliosis, hip/pelvis, lumbar, thorax, cervical shoulder, elbow, wrist/hand, and TMJ disorders). His expertise extends to vestibular rehabilitation, neurological rehabilitation, headaches and oral facial pain, chronic pain, and Complex Regional Pain I (formerly known as Reflex Sympathetic Dystrophy Syndrome (RSDS)). He is former Sports Medicine Faculty at Oregon State University and currently lectures on Proprioception, Manual Therapy, Advanced TMJ Diagnostic and Treatment, and many other areas of rehabilitation.

TREATMENT PHILOSOPHY

His treatment philosophy is assessment based treatment, combining an eclectic approach of both evidence based and other internationally recognized approaches to create a treatment program that will allow the patient to succeed. Jeff's treatment approach combines many assessment and treatment paradigms including osteopathic, myofascial, Strain/Counterstrain, PNF, Canadian, British, Norwegian, McKenzie Method, Athletic Training and motor control/program theory, with team approach between clinician and patient towards independent management of their problem. His development of ***Dynamic Proprioception*** ©, which he has started teaching in 2003, has resulted in helping clients reach a higher level of physical function. His background in motor control & motor learning has allowed him to apply this to both spine and extremity, combining this with movement awareness training, and advancing motor skills.
