COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course will focus on being able to Evaluate for Proprioceptive deficits of any upper and lower quarter problem, how this relates to present musculoskeletal diagnosis, and how to integrate with any existing treatment the clinician may already be providing. Appropriate for either the clinician that practices in orthopedic and sports setting or neurologic setting.

This course will review the present literature, the anatomy of proprioception, present case studies in review, as well as including working with patients (live case studies) in terms of practicing new skills taught.

Participants should come prepared to actively participate in laboratory sessions for upper and lower quarter.

He has practiced at the Olympic level in 2000, and worked at the level Professional Athletics in the areas of Track and Field and US Figure Skating. His expertise extends to orthopaedic manual therapy (OMT) and is a Fellow with the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Physical Therapy (AAOMPT). He is a Board Certified Orthopaedic Clinical Specialist (OCS) through the APTA Board of Physical Therapist Specialities, is a Board Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) through the National Athletic Trainers' Association, Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist (CSCS) through the National Strength and Conditioning Association and Certified Orthopaedic Manual Therapy.
