He has been recognized internationally as a Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Therapy (FAAOMPT) as having advanced competencies in clinical, analytical, and hands-on skills in the treatment of musculoskeletal (Orthopaedic) disorders. He has expertise in differential diagnosis, primary care screening, pharmacology, radiology and imaging, manual therapy, therapeutic interventions, health care management, prevention and wellness, health promotion, histology, and pathology. He was in the first 500 PT's to be made a Fellow in the United States of America. Currently there are less than 1% of Physical Therapists in the USA who have received this title.

He has clinical experience of 35 years, dating back to 1988 in the professions of Athletic Training and Physical Therapy.
